Hi All

In regards to the Spring Break I know Adrian has had the accounts audited, but I have an unaudited copy which goes through the income and expenses for anyone there tomorrow to look at. If memory serves the holiday made £74.00. As Adrian and I average the caravan costs over everyone (ie £64.50 each for 2018 break). We have two grades of caravan (as we will again in 2019; costs will raise to £66.50 each due to site increasing all caravan costs).

We made a profit on the bookings of £124.00, due to some people deciding to come at the last minute taking us to 40 people (break even was 38), less the £50.00 for the hire of the room on the Sunday for the quiz giving us the net profit of the £74.00.
